



MATERIALS FOR TONY'S CLASSES:

Recommended Materials for Watercolour

One large full sheet - prefer Arches 140 LB watercolour paper cut into quarters

One piece of flat material to tape the individual sheets onto (plexi, hardboard or "coroplast" best)

4 Paint tube colours (shown in order of preference): ONE RED (alizarin or rose madder or quinochridon or cadmium red medium), ONE YELLOW (cad yellow medium or lemon yellow or hansa), ONE BLUE (ultramarine or cobalt), ONE dark GREEN (viridian or pthalo). Please try to get a decent quality – not Dollar Store.

2 Brushes: one flat for wash shapes $\frac{3}{4}$ " to 1" ; one point for details (also called a round) #6 or #8 (Please try to get a decent quality – not Dollar Store.)

One roll of paper towel / Pencil HB, paper for notes

One small natural sponge (natural sponges are softer on the paper than artificial).

A palette with large wash compartments is good - BUT - several large flat white Styrofoam plates will work also and don't need cleanup.

A small 'spritzer' fine spray bottle

Water containers will be provided.

Recommended Materials for Acrylic:

2 Brushes: one flat for shapes $\frac{3}{4}$ " to 1" ; one point (also called a round) for details #6 or #8 (Please try to get a decent quality – not Dollar Store.)

6 Paint tube colours (shown in order of preference): ONE RED (alizarin or rose madder or quinochridon or cadmium red medium), ONE YELLOW (cad yellow medium or lemon yellow or hansa), ONE BLUE (ultramarine or cobalt), ONE GREEN (viridian or pthalo), ONE BLACK (small tube – any black), ONE WHITE (large tube titanium only)

Pencil HB

A palette with large wash compartments is good - BUT - several large flat white Styrofoam plates will work also and don't need cleanup.

A small spritzer fine spray bottle

One bottle of matte acrylic medium (gloss is OK also)

Two or more canvasses 16 x 20 (or your preference)

Water containers will be provided.
