

Student Supply List: Painting Animals: March 2019

Please purchase the following to bring to class:

1) Acrylic Paints:

Recommended Colours (you will be choosing which animal you would like to paint, so colour choices may vary depending on that, but a basic palette might include the following):

- titanium white
- burnt sienna
- burnt umber
- raw umber
- ivory black
- ultramarine blue
- cadmium red
- yellow ochre
- alizarin crimson permanent
- cadmium yellow
- viridian green
- phthalo blue
- acrylic glazing medium

2) Brushes:

-a variety of soft and firm brushes in both filbert and round brush heads. Recommended brush sizes from 0-8. Bristles should ideally have some 'spring' to them and not be too soft/floppy (such as Opus Legato Brushes). Make sure to purchase acrylic specific brushes. Student grade bristle brushes will be available for use in class, but it is strongly recommended that you bring some higher quality ones as well for blending and fine detail.

3) **Canvas or Panel:** Please bring a canvas to create your painting on (suggested sizes include 16"x20", 20"x20" or 18"x24"). You will likely only need one canvas for the course, but if you are a fast painter, you may wish to purchase an additional one. The canvas size is flexible so choose one that suits your artistic preferences even if not listed.

4) Optional: Specific Reference Images

Students may wish to bring specific reference photos of animals or pets they wish to draw/paint. A variety of reference images will also be available in class if you do not wish to bring your own. If you are bringing your own, it is recommended you select a high quality image with a good range of contrast. We can discuss choices during the first class.

Provided Supplies (the following supplies will be available for use during class):

- small round palettes for mixing (you may wish to purchase a larger one separately)
- student-grade bristle brushes
- additional acrylic colours/mediums for backgrounds etc.
- scrap paper for drawing/planning compositions (or you can bring your own sketchbook)
- basic drawing supplies (HB pencil, basic willow charcoal, erasers)
- a variety of optional reference images
